

A Live Tree For Christmas? Great Idea!

Here's How We Make It Work At Lodi Farms Nursery...

- 1) Your tree can ONLY be INSIDE for 5-7 days maximum. More than that will cause the tree to “wake up” (break dormancy) which could cause serious harm to the tree.
- 2) It’s “easy in, easy out” with the tree: before you bring it inside for the 5-7 days, bring it into the garage, unheated porch, etc to “warm up” for a day or two, then into the house for the 5-7 days, then back to the garage or porch for at least a week to let it “cool down.”
- 3) Keep your tree watered while it is in the house, and in a cool place (away from direct sunlight and heat vents) if at all possible.
- 4) When your tree is cooled down, set it outside, in a protected area out of direct sunlight (next to the house is great), cover the pot with leaves, mulch, or straw, etc., and plant it in the spring.
- 5) This is a weird thing to do to a tree, so we do not guarantee our Live Christmas Trees.
